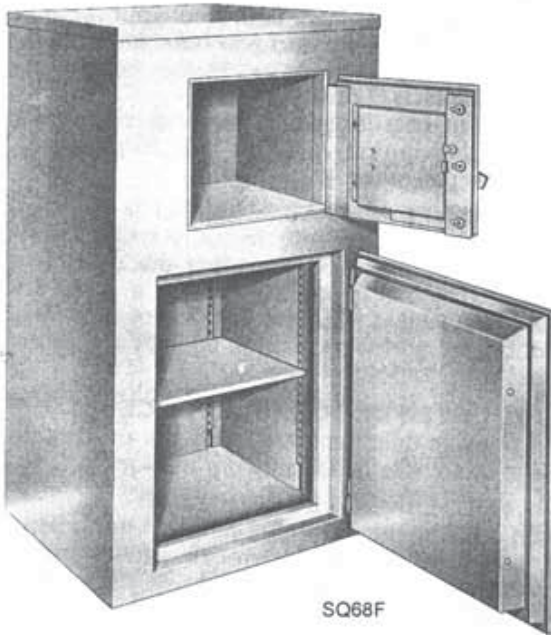


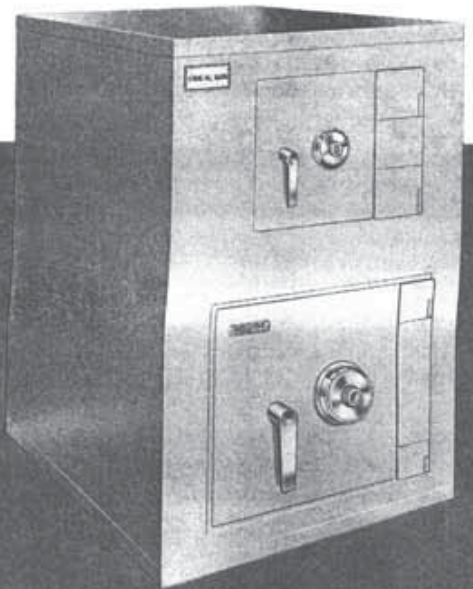
# H-H-M MONEY/ RECORD SAFES

Record Money Safes combine the features of a record safe and a money safe in a single unit. The physical protection offered by the money safe, plus the bulk storage for records and other items provided by the record safe section make these units practical for many different applications. Both units are encased in a single steel-clad concrete block. Floor space is conserved by this dual purpose unit while its extra weight offers additional protection against removal from the premises. Robbery resistance may be provided in the money safe by the addition of inner compartments with a deposit slot. Dual control key locks guard access to inner compartments. All money safes carry the Underwriters' Laboratories Labels. Standard interior equipment may be installed in record safe sections.



The money safe of these combination units provides security comensurate with the U.L. label while the unlabeled record container may be used for register tills, cash boxes or records.

## H-H-M TL-15 DEPOSITORY SAFES

Collectors money safes are designed primarily for route salesmen or others who must turn in collections. Safes permit deposits to be made without other personnel on duty. Key locking dial on receiving safe provides dual control. SQ47 and SQ48 will handle packages 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  x 7 x 11 $\frac{3}{8}$ .

NOTE 1: Both SQ47 and SQ48 are padlocked.

NOTE 2: Doors on SQ47 face in same direction.

NOTE 3: Doors on SQ48 face in opposite directions.

NOTE 4: Key lock dial on Receiving Money Safe.

NOTE 5: Add 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " over all on Handls SQ47.

NOTE 6: Add 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " over all on Handls SQ48.

NOTE 7: Upper depository door is round, lower receiving door is square.
